## **Hurricane Plan**

When they log into the Portal, all students have an annual requirement to complete a Hurricane/Evacuation Plan before proceeding. In the event of a tropical storm or hurricane forecasted to affect the College's area, residents will be guided to safely evacuate campus. With communication between the College and students, students and their families, and the College and families, safe evacuation plans may include traveling home, temporarily relocating to a shelter, staying with a friend, or—if evacuation is not possible and the student has authorization—temporarily relocating to shelter in a safe place on campus.
